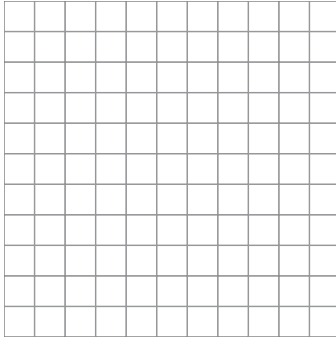
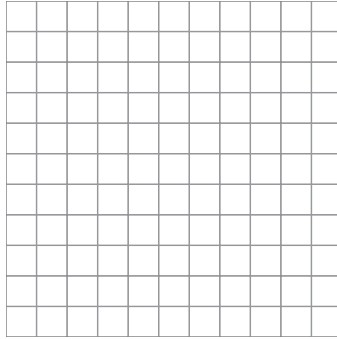


# Typeface Prototypes

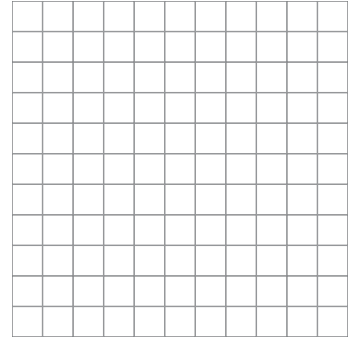
